TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip coach class on American, Delta, United or other IATA member. Meals served in flight.

LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES: By deluxe air-conditioned motor coach with professional driver, services of an English-speaking Tour Director, local guides, all admission & entrance fees and transfers to and from international airports. Mass scheduled daily. Daily schedule as per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

LODGING: First-class accommodations, based upon double occupancy with very limited single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$600.

MEALS: Breakfast buffet and Dinner DAILY.

ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE: All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

GROUP REQUIREMENT: The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT: A deposit/payment of \$500 towards the price of the tour, per person is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full 60 days prior to departure; August 10, 2017. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$100 late payment fee. Reservations made within 30 days of departure may be subject to a \$100 late reservation fee. Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance brochure will be mailed to you.

INSURANCE: Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by CSA Travel Protection's plan, as long as your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. Waivers for pre-existing medical conditions are available at no additional cost, but your policy must be purchased before your final payment for the tour.

CANCELLATION FEES: Passengers not taking the CSA travel insurance need to be aware of the following cancellation fees. From day of registration to 60 days prior to departure, there is a non-refundable administration fee of \$50. The remaining cancellation fee schedule is as follows: 89-60 days = \$300; 59-46 days = 50% of tour price; 45-30 days = 75% of tour price; 29-15 days = 80% of tour price; 14 days or less = 100% of tour price.

DAILY MASS AT THE HOLY SITES

Fatima Apparitions 100 Year Anniversary Marian Shrines Pilgrimage to Portugal, Spain & France

October 9, 2017 - Monday SAN FRANCISCO / PORTUGAL

Today we depart San Francisco International Airport for our flight to Lisbon, Portugal, arriving the next morning. Meals are served on board.

October 10, 2017 - Tuesday LISBON / SANTAREM / FATIMA

Today we arrive in Lisbon and meet our Pilgrimage Tours' tour director who will remain with us until the end of our tour. We transfer to the city of Lisbon, where we will celebrate Mass at the birthplace of St. Anthony of Padua, followed by a panoramic tour of the city. En route to Fatima, we stop for a visit at the Church of St. Stephen, or "Church of the Holy Miracle" in Santarem, site of a 13th century Eucharistic miracle. Finally we arrive in Fatima where in 1917 Mary appeared to local children and the "miracle of the sun" occurred. This year marks the 100th anniversary of the Fatima Apparitions. Following dinner we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

October 11, 2017 - Wednesday FATIMA

This morning we participate in the Stations of the Cross along the path that the shepherd children used to tend to their flock en route to the Cova de Iria where Our Lady appeared to the children. Here we pause to recite the Holy Rosary. Next we visit nearby Aljustrel to visit the House of Lucia and House of Francisco and Jacinta. In the afternoon we will visit the Shrine and Basilica of Our Lady where we celebrate Mass, followed by free time to explore the sanctuary's grounds. Following dinner this evening, we have another opportunity to join the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Fatima.

October 12, 2017 - Thursday FATIMA / SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA

This morning we depart Fatima for the home of St. James, Santiago de Compostela, where upon our arrival, we enjoy a walking tour of the historical center of Santiago, including a visit to the Cathedral of St. James the Apostle, housing the remains of the Saint. The Cathedral's facades display examples of both Romanesque and Baroque architecture. We celebrate Mass in the Cathedral of St. James. Dinner and overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

October 13, 2017 - Friday SANTIAGO de COMPOSTELA / COVADONGA

This morning we drive to the town of Covadonga. Upon our arrival in Covadonga, we explore the city prior to arriving at the Basilica of Santa Maria la Real de Covadonga, housing the statue of Our Lady of Covadonga, where Pope John Paul II visited in 1989. While at the Sanctuary, we will learn the inspiring story of Our Lady of Covadonga as well as celebrate Mass. Dinner and overnight in Covadonga.

October 14, 2017 - Saturday COVADONGA / SAN SEBASTIAN

Today we enjoy a drive near the northern coast of Spain and arrive at the seaside town of San Sebastian to walk and explore the streets and shops in Old Town, where we see the beautiful city hall building situated across from the beautiful Bay of Biscay. In the afternoon we arrive at the Cathedral of the Good Shepherd for a visit and celebration of Mass. Dinner and overnight in San Sebastian.

October 15, 2017 - Sunday SAN SEBASTIAN / LOURDES

This morning we depart San Sebastian and enter France en route to Lourdes, where in 1858, Mary appeared to a young Bernadette Soubirous. Upon our arrival in Lourdes, we enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes where we visit the places important in the life of Bernadette, including the Grotto and Spring where Mary appeared to Bernadette numerous times and the nearby Healing Baths where many pilgrims have submerged themselves for its healing properties. Following Mass at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception (Upper Basilica), we will visit the

Rosary Basilica (Lower Basilica) as well as the Basilica of Pius X, followed by a visit to Bernadette's home and the Museum of Lourdes. Following dinner we participate in the evening's Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 16, 2017 - Monday LOURDES / BARTRES / ST. SAVIN

This morning we celebrate Mass in the Grotto. Following Mass, we enjoy free time at the shrine and an opportunity for those who would like to visit the Healing Baths. In the afternoon we will explore the countryside known by St. Bernadette with a trip into the snowcapped Pyrenees Mountains. First we visit Bartres, where Bernadette lived and then we will make a stop to visit the old Benedictine Abbey in the village of St. Savin. We return to Lourdes and gather together for walking the Stations of the Cross. The remainder of the day is free for personal exploration at the Lourdes Sanctuary. This evening offers another opportunity to participate in the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes.

October 17, 2017 - Tuesday LOURDES / ZARAGOZA

This morning we bid farewell to Lourdes and arrive in the town of Zaragoza, where upon our arrival we enjoy free time for lunch and shopping. Next we will visit and celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of the Pillar, the place where Mary appeared to the Apostle James before her Assumption into heaven. Following Mass at the basilica, we arrive at our hotel for dinner and overnight in Zaragoza.

October 18, 2017 - Wednesday ZARAGOZA / BARCELONA

Today we continue on to Barcelona, where upon our arrival we enjoy a motor coach tour of this cosmopolitan city, including a visit to its Gothic Quarter. Next we will visit the impressive Basilica of the Sagrada Familia, one of the largest churches in Europe. Here we will learn the history of the basilica, including its initial ground-breaking in 1882 and its construction which became the life's work of Antoni Gaudi until his death in 1926. Following Mass at Sagrada Familia we arrive at our hotel for dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

October 19, 2017 - Thursday BARCELONA / MANRESA / MONTSERRAT

This morning we embark on a day trip to the wonderful mountaintop Sanctuary of Montserrat. En route we will visit the town of Manresa along the River Cardoner. It is here that St. Ignatius of Loyola, founder of the Jesuits, or Society of Jesus, spent some 10 months in prayer and meditation and where St. Ignatius saw a vision and went on to write the "Spiritual Exercises". Next we arrive in Montserrat where we enjoy a tour of the monastery and its grounds, including a visit and celebration of Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat or Black Madonna, probably Spain's most fervent devotion to the Blessed Mother. We also observe the Way of the Cross and enjoy some of the most incredible scenery in Spain. We return to Barcelona for dinner and overnight.

October 20, 2017 - Friday BARCELONA

Following Mass this morning, we will arrive at the famous Las Ramblas Boulevard, one of the most upbeat and striking boulevards in all of Europe. Here we will enjoy free time for shopping and personal exploration of this vibrant city for the remainder of our day. Dinner and overnight in Barcelona.

October 21, 2017 - Saturday BARCELONA / SAN FRANCISCO

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our connecting flight back home. Though our pilgrimage draws to a close, its blessings will last a lifetime and its graces are certain to draw us closer each day to the Lord.
